1. It is who he called you to be
2. It is how he leads you

Read the scriptures below noticing how Jesus shows us God's purpose for sending us. Discuss what stands out to you.

Luke 10:1-3 The Lord now chose seventy-two other disciples and sent them ahead in pairs to all the towns and places he planned to visit. These were his instructions to them: "The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields. **Now go, and remember that I am sending you** out as lambs among wolves.

John 20:19-22 That Sunday evening the disciples were meeting behind locked doors because they were afraid of the Jewish leaders. Suddenly, Jesus was standing there among them! "Peace be with you," he said. As he spoke, he showed them the wounds in his hands and his side. They were filled with joy when they saw the Lord! Again he said, "Peace be with you. **As the Father has sent me, so I am sending you.**" Then he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit.

Matthew 28:18-20

Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. **Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit**, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
